Onsite registration will require an additional \$25 fee.** Tuition and fees will be refunded in full minus a \$25 administration fee if cancellations are made before September 18, 2006. Cancellations after September 18, 2006 will not receive a refund.

Registration for Workshops: This is first come first serve due to limited seating. Please mark the workshop if wish to attend and include a **separate** check. Workshop Registrations will not be accepted without proper payment. A wait list will be maintained for workshop. Please inform the registration desk if you are unable to attend or if (space available) you would like to register to participate on site.
