Registration: Registration must be postmarked by September 5, 2006 to be pre-registered. **A fee of \$25** will be added after this date. Onsite registration will require an additional \$25 fee. Tuition and fees will be refunded in full minus a \$25 administration fee if cancellations are made before September 18, 2006. Cancellations after September 18, 2006 will not receive a refund.

Registration for Workshops: This is first come first serve due to limited seating. Please mark the workshop if wish to attend and include a **separate** check.
